On July 1st 2016 Vulcanair Aircraft attended the official delivery and commissioning of the first P68 Observer 2 to Chilean Navy fleet at Con Con base in Chile.

Remo De Feo, Vulcanair CEO, said “ The reception was extraordinary and the event was very important with all the generals of the Chilean navy, included the Italian military attaches (Marina) and Carabinieri.

This is the first of 7 Vulcanair Observer Aircraft purchased by the Chileans to replace their veterans Cessna O- 2A Skymaster .

The new P68 Observer 2, Italian piston twin-engine aircraft will be used for patrol , search and rescue, transport , reconnaissance and medical evacuation .
